In order to find the actual roll number of all children receiving primary education in schools subject to inspection, it will be necessary to take into account those attending Native village schools, schools at the Chatham Islands, private primary schools subject to inspection, and the lower departments of secondary schools, and to deduct those on the rolls of the secondary departments of district high schools.
