MANUNUI DOMAIN.

Section No. 15, Manunui Village. Area, 54 acres.

Work done during year: Willows planted along river bank for protective purposes, dead trees removed, and noxious weeds cleared. Improvements now on domain: Fencing. Used for sports, picnics, and as a pleasure resort. Leased on improvement-conditions.

MARIMA DOMAIN.

Section No. 58, Block X, Mangahao Survey District. Area, 22 acres.

Work done during year: Fencing and gates erected, and 6 chains of willows planted along river bank to prevent erosion. Improvements now on domain: Fencing, tree-planting, and gates. Used for grazing. Proposed operations for ensuing year: Fencing and clearing an area for a recreation-ground.

MATAROA DOMAIN.

Sections Nos. 1 to 6, and 16, Suburbs of Mataroa. Area, 10 acres 2 roods 10 perches. Improvements now on domain: Fences and shed. Used for football and picnics.

Maungaraki Domain.

Subdivisions Nos. 6 and 8A, Maungaraki Block, and Block VIII, Belmont Survey District. Area, 107 acres 2 roods 20 perches.

The Board was appointed on the 1st November, 1911. It is proposed to cut a track to define the boundary, and to clear noxious weeds. Used as a camping-ground for picnic parties.

MOWHANAU DOMAIN.

Sections Nos. 18, 66, and 70, Mowhanau Village. Area, 12 acres 1 rood 3 perches.

Improvements now on domain: Fencing, draining, and plantations. Used for picnics and bathing. Proposed operations for ensuing year: Fencing, draining, erecting a culvert, and forming a path to beach.

NEWMAN DOMAIN.

Suburban Sections Nos. 30 and 115, Town of Newman. Area, 26 acres and 24 perches.

Work done during year: New iron gates erected, fences shifted, trees planted, conveniences, shed for copper, tables, and seats erected, and site for picnics cleared. Improvements now on domain: Felling, stumping, ploughing, and grassing, fencing, shrubs, trees, and hedge, conveniences, shed with copper inserted, and tables and seats. Used for sports, picnics, and leased for grazing. Proposed operations for ensuing year: General improvements.

NUKUMARU DOMAIN.

Sections Nos. 63 and 66, Block XIII, Nukumaru Survey District, and 67, 71, and 71A, Block XIV, Wairoa Survey District. Area, 1,220 acres.

During the year a road has been formed to give access to the domain, which has been fenced. Improvements now on domain: Fencing, trees, and grassing. Used for picnics and by fishing parties. Proposed operations for ensuing year: Erecting a building for the use of picnic parties.

OHAKUNE LAKES DOMAIN.

Section No. 24c, Block VIII, Makotuku Survey District. Area, 96 acres 1 rood.

Work done during year: Fencing. Improvements now on domain: Fencing. Used for picnics and grazing. Leased. Proposed operations for ensuing year: Clearing, fencing, and beautifying the domain.

OKOTUKU DOMAIN.

Sections Nos. 338 and 140, Block VII, Wairoa Survey District. Area, 159 acres 3 roods 33 perches.

Work done during year: Fences repaired, trees planted, and general maintenance. Improvements now on domain: Buildings, fencing, plantation, grassing, water-supply, and rifle range. Used for picnics, military emcampments and tournaments, and rifle shooting. Leased.

ORAUKURA DOMAIN.

Section No. 65, Block XIV, Ohinewairua Survey District. Area, 9 acres 2 roods.

This domain is under the control of the Commissioner of Crown Lands, Wellington. Leased for a term of fourteen years from the 1st January, 1907. Seven acres have been ploughed and sown in grass and oats, and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acres grassed. There are 30 chains of boundary-fences on the domain.

OTAKI DOMAIN.

Part of Haruatai No. 11 Block, Block IX, Waitohu Survey District. Area, 6 acres and 17 perches. Improvements now on domain: Fencing, grassing, and plantations. Used for sports.

OWHANGO DOMAIN.

Sections Nos. 5 to 16, Block III, and 5 to 16, 21, 22, and 23, Block IV, Town of Owhango; and 47, Block X, Hunua Survey District. Area, 15 acres and 16 perches.

This domain is under the control of the Commissioner of Crown Lands, Wellington. Improvements now on domain: Part of the natural clearing has been levelled for a sports-ground. The residents are taking action with a view to forming a Domain Board.
