PROGRESSIVE LAND-TAX
(AMOUNTS PAYABLE BY WAY OF).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 14th August, 1912.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing the amount payable by way of progressive land-tax at (a) the present rate of tax, and (b) on the new rate of tax, on £5,000, £6,000, £7,000, £8,000, £9,000, £10,000, £15,000, £20,000, £25,000, £30,000, £35,000, £40,000, £50,000, £60,000, £70,000, £80,000, £90,000, £100,000, £125,000, £150,000, £175,000, and £200,000."—(Mr. ELL.)
