NOTES TO SCHEDULE ABOVE.

* No other allowances are given, and all travelling-expenses and hire of lodgings, camp furniture when at schools of instruction and manoeuvres, have to be paid out of this.
(a.) The Imperial Government pays Colonel Robin's travelling allowances and expenses when detailed for duty by the Chief of the General Staff, War Office. When paid by Imperial Government Colonel Robin will not draw travelling-allowances from New Zealand Government.
(b.) Colonel Davies is paid solely by the Imperial Government.
(c.) The following officers are paid by the New Zealand Government in the first instance, but the Imperial Government refunds to the New Zealand Government the amount of the regimental pay of each at the rate of 6s. 6d. per diem: (1) Lieut. W. McG. Turnbull; (2) Lieut. A. H. Burn; (3) Lieut. M. L. Garland; (4) Lieut. I. T. Standish; (5) Lieut. W. W. A. Burn; (6) Lieut. A. H. Piper; (7) Lieut. J. L. H. Turner; (8) Lieut. H. A. Davies. With the exceptions in (a), (b), and (c), the salaries and allowances are paid by the New Zealand Government.
