The result of the University examinations as affecting the College was: 10 students obtained the degree of Master of Arts, 9 with honours; 1 student graduated as M.Sc. with honours; 3 gained the degree of LL.M., 2 with honours; 6 gained Senior University Scholarships; 29 obtained the degree of B.A.; 37 passed the first section of the B.A. degree; 4 passed the first section of the B.Sc. degree; 52 passed sections of the LL.B. degree; 20 obtained the degree of LL.B. To one was awarded the 1851 Exhibition Scholarship.

In presenting this report, I am directed by the Council to say that, in its opinion, the time has come when it is urgently necessary that there should be made provision for day-teaching at Victoria College.
