FINAL REPORT.

I have the honour to report that the Railways Committee held its final meeting on the 9th day of December, 1913.

During the session the Committee met on 36 occasions, the average attendance being 6.3.

Upon the petition of Archibald Grandison and 23 others, re New Lynn Railway accident, the Committee occupied seven days in taking evidence and deliberating, and duly reported its findings to the House, the report being referred to the Government.

The Committee has taken considerable evidence upon the petitions of the Amalgamated Society of Railway Servants; M. J. Mack, secretary of the Amalgamated Society of Railway Servants; M. H. Quinn and 36 others (New Zealand Locomotive Engine-drivers, Firemen, and Cleaners' Association), and 54 similar petitions; and S. Kennedy and 8 others (New Zealand Locomotive Engine-drivers, Firemen, and Cleaners' Association). Further consideration of these petitions has been adjourned until next session.

The total number of petitions held over for consideration next session is 66.

The Government Railways Amendment Bill was referred to the Committee, duly considered, and reported upon.

The number of reports brought down by the Committee and presented to the House was 51.
