## NEW ZEALAND STATE-GUARANTEED ADVANCES OFFICE:

RETURNS RELATIVE TO APPLICATIONS FOR LOANS REFUSED, AND AMOUNTS PAID TO  
SOLICITORS FOR PREPARING DEEDS.

*Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 29th August, 1912.*
