Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 3rd October, 1912.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The number of co-operative workers employed by the Government for each month from the 31st March, 1911, to the 1st September, 1912; (2) the average amount of money earned per man per hour when working for the above-mentioned period; and (3) the average amount earned per man per week for the time named."—(Mr. WITTY.)
