Retiring and other Allowances.—Pensions for £13,244 14s. per annum were granted during the year as follows: For age or length of service, £11,242 19s. per annum to 100 members (ninety-five male and five female members); for medical unfitness for duty, £636 15s. to eleven members (nine male and two female members; to widows and children of deceased members, £702 per annum to thirty-nine widows, and £663 per annum to fifty-one children.
