Mr. Buddo, Mr. Buick, Mr. Dickie, Mr. W. H. Field, Mr. Forbes, Mr. Hunter, Mr. Sykes, Mr. Talbot. Mr. Wilkinson, and the mover."—(Right Hon. Mr. Massey.)
