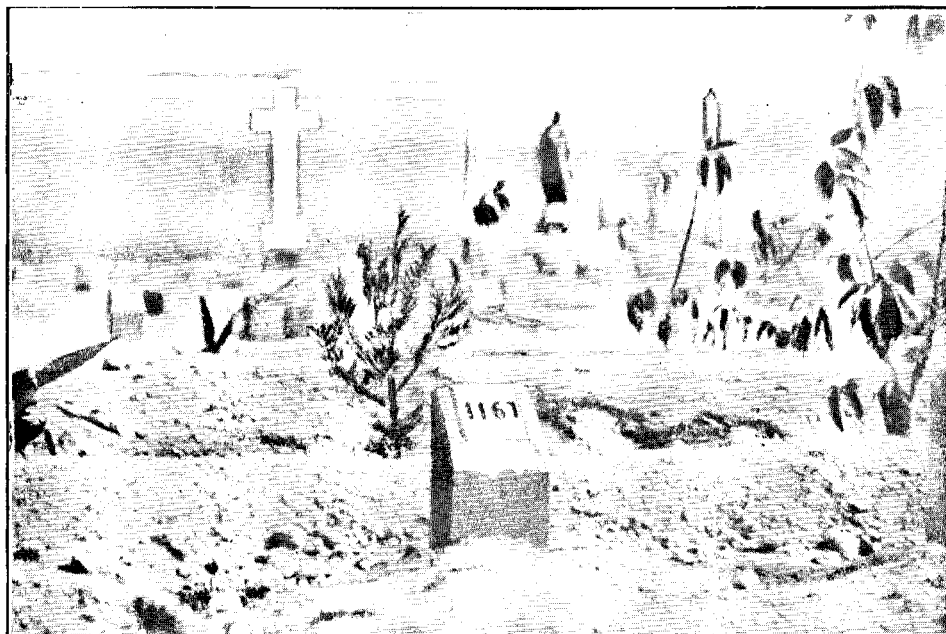
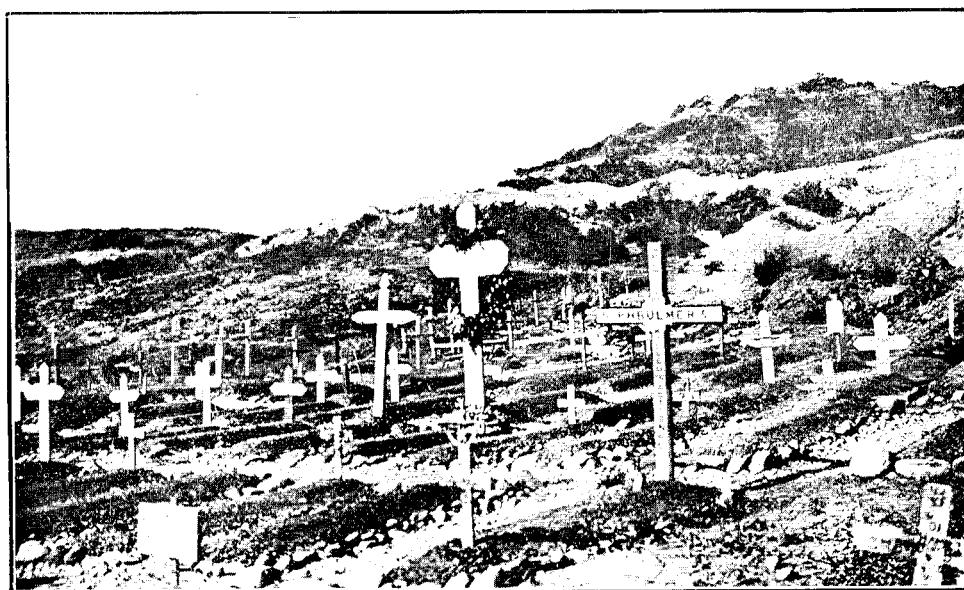




PART OF CHATBY MILITARY CEMETERY, ALEXANDRIA, SHOWING CONCRETE BLOCKS
