POSTPONEMENT OF RENT.

Under the provisions of section 13 of the Land Laws Amendment Act, 1912, postponements of rent amounting to £18,894 were granted to 278 tenants. Under ordinary Crown lands the amount postponed was £3.001 and the number of tenants 82; on land-for-settlement holdings £15,216 to 180 tenants, and on national-endowment lands £677 to 16 tenants. The total amount remaining postponed at the 31st March last was £23,514.
