EXPEDITIONARY FORCE TRAINING-CAMPS.

PARTICULARS OF RENT AND PAYMENT RECEIVED BY GOVERNMENT FOR TRADING-RIGHTS.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 1st June, 1916.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing the total amount of rent and payments received by the Government for trading-rights at all the military training-camps since the declaration of war and up to and including the 20th May, 1916."—(Mr. ELL.)

RENT AND PAYMENTS RECEIVED BY THE GOVERNMENT FOR TRADING-RIGHTS AT TRAINING-CAMPS.

THE total amount of rent and payments received by the Government for trading-rights at military training-camps since the declaration of the war up to and including the 20th May, 1916, is £20,750.
