The amounts shown in the lists attached to the balance-sheets are those actually disbursed during the year, and do not represent the total annual allowances granted by the Board to the 31st March, 1918, which were,—

Since the inauguration of the fund 401 beneficiaries have, however, died, and 11 members who had been placed on the fund as "medically unfit" resumed duty. The fund was relieved of an annual liability of £27,878 13s. 11d. in respect to these 412 members; 326 children have reached the age of fourteen years, 8 children have died, 51 widows remarried, 28 widows died, 1 widow refused allowance, and 1 allowance remains unclaimed; lessening the liability of the fund by an additional £5,812 10s. 6d. per annum. There were 1,622 persons actually on the fund at the 31st March, 1918, involving an annual liability of £98,324 10s. 4d.
