RETURN OF NUMBER OF MEN OVER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE GIVEN POSITIONS IN THE CIVIL SERVICE, AND NUMBER OF THESE WHO HAVE SEEN SERVICE IN THE EXPEDITIONARY FORCES OVERSEAS.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 5th August, 1920.

Ordered, "That there be laid before the House a return showing the number of men over twenty-one years of age given positions in the Civil Service since the 1st January, 1917, and the number of these who have seen service in the Expeditionary Forces overseas."—(Mr. MITCHELL.)
