On the 10th November Thomas Blake, an employee, had the misfortune to get his arm broken by a rolling stone. The face of the quarry was being operated on a gradient of about 50° of batter: a stone rolling down struck him on the arm, with the above result. Blake himself informed me that he had plenty of time to get clear, as he saw the stone rolling, and that he walked towards the face and stood behind a portion that he considered sufficient protection, but the stone swerving in the direction where he stood struck his arm. He told me that had he walked away from the face instead of towards it he would not have been struck. This accident occurred in the Whakatane Harbour Board's quarry, Whale Island. I inspected the face shortly afterwards, and found that the operations were being conducted in a satisfactory manner.
