The Urewera and other consolidation matters are progressing steadily. Some portions of the schemes have been completed and only await final orders. The Urewera Commissioners report they

have progressed as far as the position of the surveys will permit.

Two Natives were declared by the Governor-General in Council to be Europeans under the law for that purpose, making a total of fifty-six since the Act was passed in 1912.

Four Native Interpreters have been licensed during the year, all of whom were Maoris.
