FORTY-SEVENTH ANNUAL REPORT BY THE REGISTRAR OF FRIENDLY SOCIETIES
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st DECEMBER, 1923.

GENERAL.

The membership of friendly societies shows a substantial increase during the past year, the number gained being 3,451, or 4·27 per cent.

The gross funds of the societies increased by £154,260, from £2,593,692 to £2,747,952, the average capital per member being £32 12s. 6d.

The total interest-earnings of sick and funeral funds was £128,153 for the year, or a rate equal to £5 10s. 10d. per cent., an indication that in making investments advantage has been taken of the high interest rates ruling at present.

The mortality rate of 8·29 per thousand is slightly higher than that of last year. Sick-pay, per member sick, decreased from £7 8s. 3d. to £6 10s. 8d., whilst contributions and interest earned per member rose from £3 6s. 3d. to £3 7s., the whole representing a net gain per member of £1 13s. 2d., as compared with £1 16s. 4d. for the previous year.

PROSECUTIONS.

During the year two societies were prosecuted under the provisions of the Act for failing to render annual returns, and fines of £10 and £5 were inflicted. A considerable quantity of additional work is thrown on the Department by the failure of societies to send in their returns within the reasonable time allowed. It would seem as though the latitude hitherto extended in this respect must be reduced and the Act enforced more rigidly in the interests of both the Department and the offending societies.

The above figures show an increase in membership equal to 4.27 per cent., as compared with 3.81 per cent. for 1922.

The total funds of the societies and branches as on the 31st December, 1923, amounted to £2,747,952, made up as follows: Sick and Funeral Funds (inclusive of amounts transferred to special funds out of surplus, £2,565,684; Medical and Management Funds, goods, &c., £182,268. Dividing the total funds by the number of members at the end of the year it is found the average capital per member is now £32 12s. 6d.

Sickness.

The number of members sick during 1923 was 15,829, equal to 20·75 per 100 members at risk. The sickness experienced during 1923 was 156,881 weeks, equal to 9 weeks 5 days per sick member, and 2 weeks for each member at risk.

Mortality.

Sick and Funeral Funds.

The contributions and entrance fees paid to Sick and Funeral Funds in 1923 amounted to £148,201. Divided by the mean number of members the average for 1923 was £1 15s. 11d., as compared with £1 15s. 9d. in 1922.

The interest and rent received by the lodges and central bodies amounted to £128,153 in 1923, equal to £1 11s. 1d. per member, as against £1 10s. 6d. for 1922.

The amount of sickness benefit paid was £103,407 in 1923, equal to £6 10s. 8d. per member sick, and £1 5s. 1d. per member, as against £7 8s. 3d. and £1 3s. 10d. respectively for 1922. Viewing the amount paid in relation to the weeks of sickness, the average benefit per week is found to be 13s. 2d. in 1923, as against 13s. for 1922.

The funeral benefit paid amounted to £30,257 in 1923, equal to 7s. 4d. per member, as compared with 7s. 3d. for 1922.

The total worth of the Sick and Funeral Funds of 774 lodges at the beginning of 1923 was £2,308,155, and at the end of the year £2,445,025. The balance of gain for the year was £136,870, or £1 13s. 2d. per member, in 1923, as compared with £144,144, or £1 16s. 4d., in 1922.

Investment of Funds.

The net income from investments credited to the Sick and Funeral Funds for 1923 amounted to £128,153, the average rate being £5 10s. 10d. per cent., as against £5 11s. 2d. in 1922.
