Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 30th July, 1925.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The amount and value of motor-spirit and benzine imported into the Dominion during 1924, and (2) the amount of duty paid on motor-vehicles, including lorries and motor-cycles and accessories, imported during 1924."—(Mr. JORDAN.)
