FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER, 1926.

GENERAL.

Mr. William M. Wright vacated the office of Registrar during the year.

The membership of friendly societies increased from 91,353 to 94,467, a gain of 3,114, equal to 3·41 per cent. This increase, although slightly less than in each of the three preceding years, indicates the continued popularity of the friendly-society movement in New Zealand.

The total accumulated funds of the societies increased by £201,446, from £3,136,237 to £3,337,683, the average capital per member now being £35 6s. 8d., as compared with £34 6s. 7d. for the year 1925.

The total net interest earnings of the Sick and Funeral Funds during the year was £159,103. This represents a rate equal to 5·81 per cent., as against 5·75 per cent. for the previous year.

The average contributions and interest per member credited to the Sick and Funeral Funds increased from £3 10s. 3d. to £3 11s. 4d., and the cost of sickness and funeral benefits per member at risk from £1 9s. 8d. to £1 12s. 9d., the total increase in these funds representing a net gain of £1 19s. 4d. per member.

The mortality-rate increased from 7·22 to 8·02 per thousand members at risk.

The above figures show an increase in membership equal to 3·41 per cent., as compared with 4·48 per cent. for 1925.

The total funds of the societies and branches as on the 31st December, 1926, amounted to £3,337,683, made up as follows: Sick and Funeral Funds (inclusive of amounts transferred to special funds out of surplus), £3,103,473; Medical and Management Funds, goods, &c., £234,210. Dividing the total funds by the number of members at the end of the year it is found the average capital per member is now £35 6s. 8d.

These sums are, of course, held against the societies' liabilities under their sickness and funeral insurances, and the actuarial reports issued from time to time indicate how far they are sufficient or otherwise.

Sickness.

The number of members sick during 1926 was 17,827, equal to 21·1 per 100 members at risk. The sickness experienced during 1926 was 177,240 weeks, equal to 10 weeks per sick member, and 2 weeks 1 day for each member at risk.

Mortality.

Sick and Funeral Funds.

The contributions and entrance fees paid to Sick and Funeral Funds in 1926 amounted to £172,189. Divided by the mean number of members the average for 1926 was £1 17s. 1d., as compared with £1 16s. 10d. in 1925.

The interest and rent received by the lodges and central bodies amounted to £159,103 in 1926, equal to £1 14s. 3d. per member, as against £1 13s. 5d. for 1925.

The amount of sickness benefit paid was £117,083 in 1926, equal to £6 11s. 4d. per member sick, and £1 5s. 2d. per member, as against £7 2s. 8d. and £1 3s. 4d. respectively for 1925. Viewing the amount paid in relation to the weeks of sickness, the average benefit per week is found to be 13s. 3d. in 1926, as against 12s. 11d. for 1925.

The funeral benefit paid amounted to £35,227 in 1926, equal to 7s. 7d. per member, as compared with 6s. 4d. for 1925.

The total worth of the Sick and Funeral Funds of 843 lodges at the beginning of 1926 was £2,724,840, and at the end of the year £2,907,435. The balance of gain for the year was £182,595, or £1 19s. 4d. per member, in 1926, as compared with £106,514, or £1 3s. 10d., in 1925.

Investment of Funds.

The net income from investments credited to the Sick and Funeral Funds for 1926 amounted to £159,103, the average rate being £5 16s. 3d. per cent., as against £5 14s. 11d. in 1925.
