The decrease in revenue under the headings of "contributions" and "interest" is due to the fact that the 1927 figures include £20,279 contributions and £10,527 interest payable in respect to house allowance received in past years by those members who made the election under section 29 of the Finance Act, 1925 (now section 115 of the Consolidated Act of 1927) that house allowance should be counted as salary for superannuation purposes, while the figures for the year ended 31st January, 1928, include only £1,725 and £851 under these headings, respectively.

Cost-of-living Bonus.—The payment of this bonus has been continued in necessitous cases.

Retirement as permanently medically unfit.—By the provisions of section 44 of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1927, the restriction confining the benefits of the provisions of section 77 to those with over fifteen years' service has been withdrawn. Any contributor, irrespective of the length of his service, may now apply for retirement on the ground of permanent medical unfitness.
