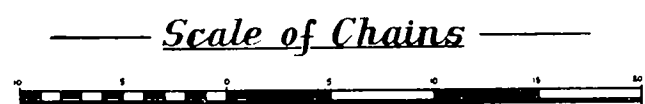


GEOLOGICAL MAP OF REEFTON COALFIELD
