#### NATIVE LAND COURTS.

The business transacted by the Native Land Court and the Native Appellate Court is set out in Table A. The fees collected amounted to £3,393, as against £3,748 for the preceding period.

## MAORI LAND BOARDS.

The Boards received in fees £1,523, as against £1,231 last year, an increase of £292, while the commissions collected rose from £2,618 last year to £3,363, an increase of £745, making a total increase of £1,037.
