The total funds of the societies and branches as at the 31st December, 1938, amounted to £5,280,472, made up as follows: Sick and Funeral Funds (inclusive of amounts transferred to special funds out of surplus), £4,867,291; Medical and Management Funds, goods, &c., £413,181. Dividing the total funds by the number of members at the end of the year it is found the average capital per member is now £46 8s. 9d.

Taking the several years 1929-38, the number of lodges whose returns were tabulated, the number of members, total funds, and average capital per member at the end of each year were as under:—

The number of members sick during 1938 was 28,682, equal to 26.9 per 100 members at risk. The sickness experienced during 1938 was 304,773 weeks, equal to 10 weeks 4 days per sick member, and 2 weeks 5 days for each member at risk.
