ORDERS OF REFERENCE.

Extracts from the Journals of the House of Representatives.

FRIDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF JULY, 1939.

Ordered, "That a Select Committee be appointed, consisting, by leave, of eighteen members, to consider all petitions, reports, returns, and other documents relating to affairs especially affecting the Native race that may be referred to it, and from time to time to report thereon to this House: the Committee to consist of Mr. Allen, the Right Hon. Mr. Coates, Mr. Cullen, Mr. Frost, Mr. Kidd, the Hon. Mr. Langstone, Mr. Lowry, the Hon. Mr. Mason, Mr. Massey, Mr. Moncur, the Hon. Sir Apirana Ngata, Mr. O'Brien, Mr. Paikea, Mr. Ratana, Mr. Thorn, Mr. Tirikatene, Mr. Williams, and the Mover."—(Hon. Mr. FRASER, for Right Hon. Mr. SAVAGE.)

THURSDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF AUGUST, 1939.

Ordered, "That all petitions not finally dealt with during the session of 1938 be again referred to the same Committees as they were referred to during the said session."—(Hon. Mr. FRASER.)

WEDNESDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1939.
