REMARKS.

- (a) Membership fee of Sixth International Congress of Surveyors, £3 6s. 7d.; compensation for horse killed while on hire to Department, £7; commission on sale of engine, £4; ammunition for official revolver, £2 5s.; hire of calculating-machine, £1 10s.; wages for fire-fighting on Crown land, £1 16s.; exchange on dishonoured cheques, £4 6s. 6d.; sundries, £2 4s.; total, £26 8s. 1d.

- (b) One half-year's rent paid in advance.

- (c) To provide for compensation to private owners of land to be taken for Wharewaka Reserve.

- (d) To provide for cost of float in connection with display to be held in January, 1940, at Auckland, as part of the Centennial celebrations.

- (e) Increase allows for outstanding commitments, £1,400.

- (f) Provides for Town Board's quota, £215, to be recovered by instalments.

- (g) Outstanding commitment of £300 to repair flood damage.
