That out of the Revenues of the Colony collected during the nine months, there had been issued, without the authority of any legislative enact-

ment, a sum not exceeding £2,113.

4. That in respect of the liabilities incurred by the Government, without reference to the period in which the same were paid, it appears that on some services provided for by the local legislature, the expenditure was less than the Estimates, and on others, greater; that the excess amounted to £17,655 6 8, and the deficiency to £7,325 9s.

Period included between 1st October, 1853, and 30th June, 1854.

Proceeding next to the financial period included between the 1st of October. 1853, and the 30th of June, 1854, it is found that the total receipts were £376,324 18s. 1d·, and the total disbursements to £342,299 2 9. These sums include both temporary and final transactions. The final receipts (freed from remittances, advances on the public service, and other temporary transactions) 30th June, 1854. No. amount to £162,567 12s. 9d., inclusive of a sum of £400 15s. 11d. received as revenue, by the Agent-General in England and the final disbursements to revenue by the Agent-General in England, and the final disbursements to 191,758 5s.
