SESSION III.

THURSDAY, AUGUST 23RD, 1855.

The House met pursuant to adjournment.

The Officer administering the Government in accordance with the wish expressed in resolution No. 35, passed by the House of Representatives last session transmits to the House the undermentioned returns.

Returns (from the Provinces named in the Margin) of all lands which have been granted without payment for Religious Educational or other Public purposes on account of public services.

The return showing the sums of money paid since the year 1848 for Religious and Educational purposes has not yet been completed but it will be furnished as soon as possible.
