

10s. Onions, 15s. Wheat, 35s to 37s
per cwt. Chaff, to £3 10s. for "prime." Out-
come straw to £5 10s per ton. Meggit's
Luncheon Meat, 25s per bag. Outback, 1s
per bag. Bran, 10s 6d per bag. Wheat
Pollard, 12s 6d per 100lb bag. Barley
Pollard, 22s 6d per 100lb bag. Oats for
feed 10s 6d per bushel.

FRUIT:—Supplies for Pears and Ap-
ples have been very busy. Prices are as
follows: Pears, 2d to 2½d per lb; Quinces,
2d to 3d per lb; Apples (dessert), 2½d to
4d per lb, according to variety and grade.
Apples (cooking), 2d to 2½d for large and
prime quality. Tomatoes (dessert), Otago
Central, to 5½d per lb. Canterbury sup-
plies are now practically finished, and the
quality of the few cases coming to hand
is poor and price ranges from 1½d to 2½d
per lb.

VEGETABLES:—Cabbages, 5s to 4s
per dozen. Cauliflowers, 4s 6d to 5s 6d
per dozen. Marrows, 9s to 10s per cwt.
Pumpkins, 9s to 10s per cwt. Carrots
local, 4s per bag. Parsnips, 5s per bag.


