

Land matters were amongst the subjects discussed at the meeting of the Dominion executive of the N.Z.R.S.A. on Saturday. Mr A. P. Whatman, who was invited to be present during the discussion, stressed the importance of pressing the provisions of the Compulsory Acquisition of Land Act, 1908. The executive resolved to interview Cabinet to-day on the land question, and, if the reply received is considered to be unsatisfactory, to arrange for the introduction of a Bill by Mr G. Mitchell, M.P., on the lines adopted by the recent general conference of the association.
