

STOR MERIDIONALIS.

The HISTORY OF THE BIRDS OF NEW ZEALAND by

Walter Lawry Buller was published in parts in 1872/73 as the first of a total of five books by Buller on the Birds of New Zealand.

It was limited to an edition of 500 copies available only on subscription. The names of the subscribers were listed in the preliminary pages.

The plates were engraved on stone by J. G. Keulemans and when printing was complete, each plate was finished by hand painting. Subscribers nominated their choice of bindings and this varied from cloth over board with gold blocking on the front and spine, to elaborate bindings in leather with extra blocking in gold. The text pages were gilded on three sides. It is valued at more than \$5000 on the international market.
