Travel via Buenos Aires and Santiago to Punta Arenas, join "World Discoverer", sail via The Beagle Channel, Drake Passage to Antarctica. Landings by Zodiac are planned at Livingstone, Petermann, Paulet and King George Islands.



Ply the stunning Lemaire Channel and Paradise Bay. Many other shore trips are planned. Return via Cape Horn to Puerto Williams, fly on to Santiago and home again via Buenos Aires, arriving December 13.

The Royal Forest & Bird Protection Society will benefit financially when members join this expedition.

Costs are from NZ\$14495.00 per person and depend on the grade of cabin chosen. They include: airfares, pre/post expedition accommodation, all meals on board ship, all excursions, whether on shore or by Zodiac, on board gratuities, travel insurance, New Zealand departure tax, and airport transfers.
