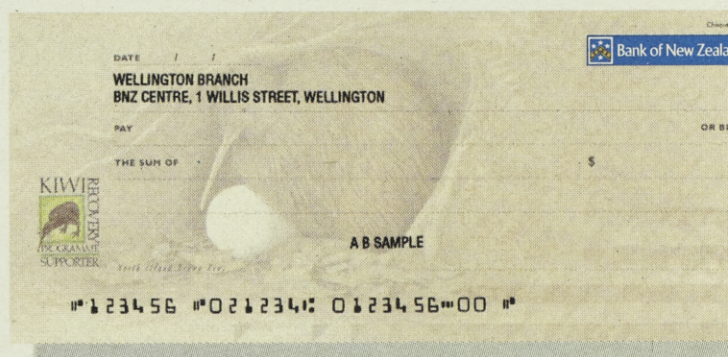


The Kiwi Recovery Plan

of New Zealand and the Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society, mounted the Kiwi Recovery Programme in 1991.

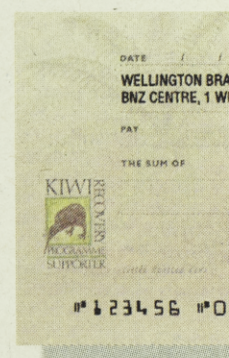
In combining research and action to save the Kiwi, members of the team have already discovered there are actually at least six varieties of Kiwi, not five as previously believed. What hasn't changed is the threat they face.
