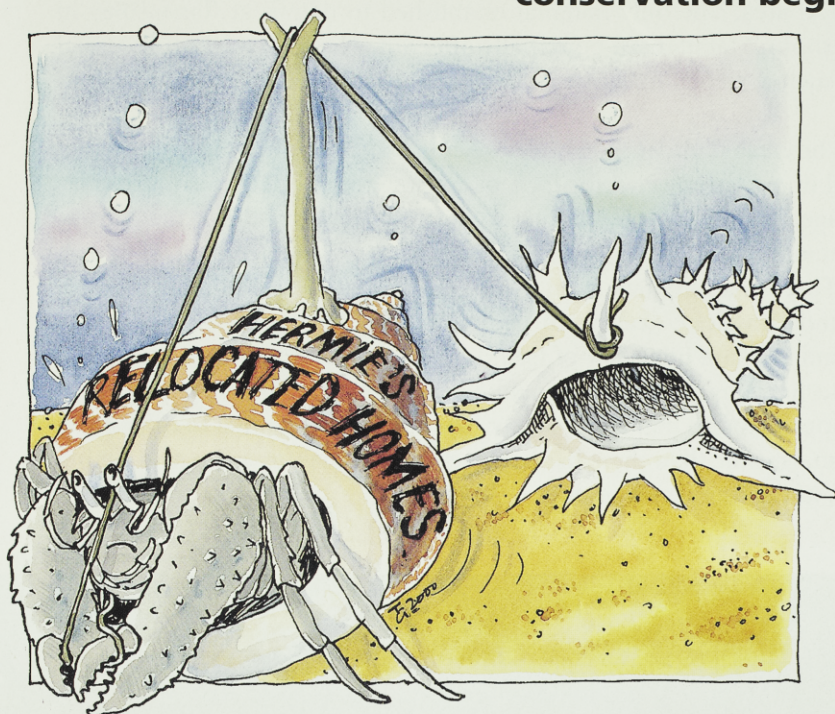


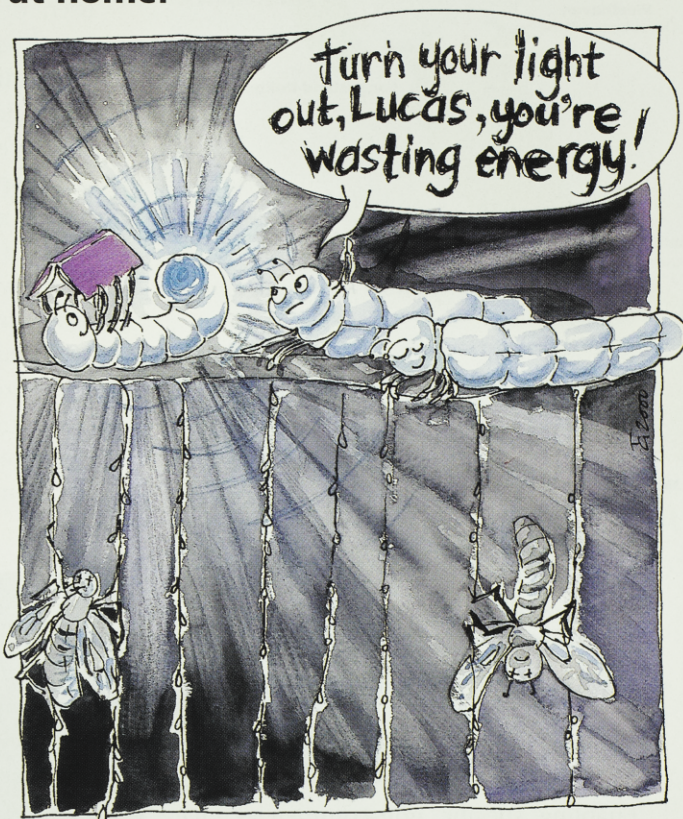

ANN GRAEME and illustrator TIM GALLOWAY show how conservation begins at home.



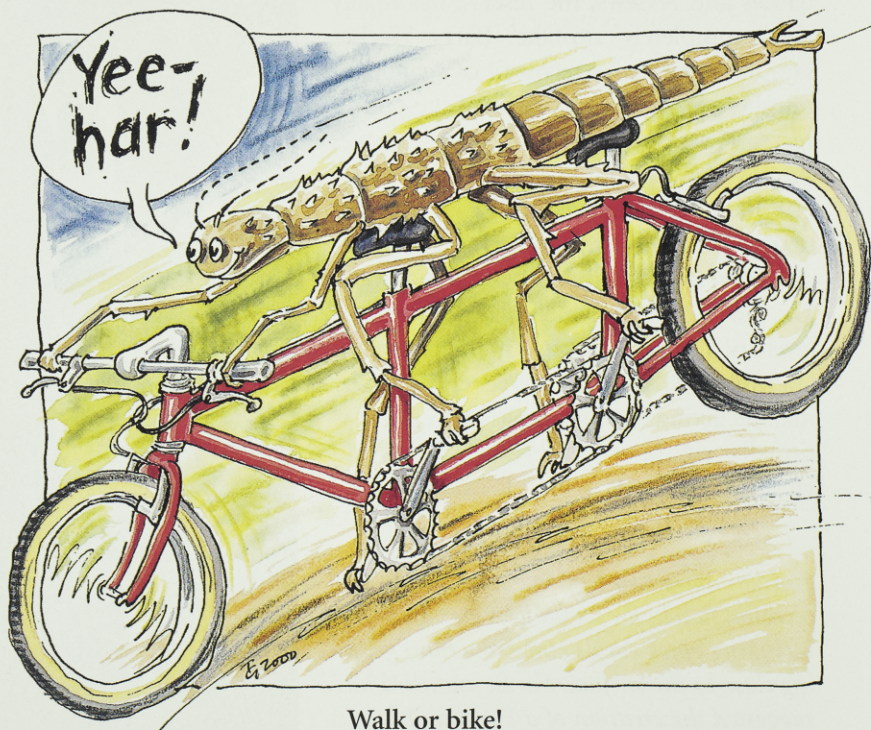
Fix and re-use — don't throw it away!
