

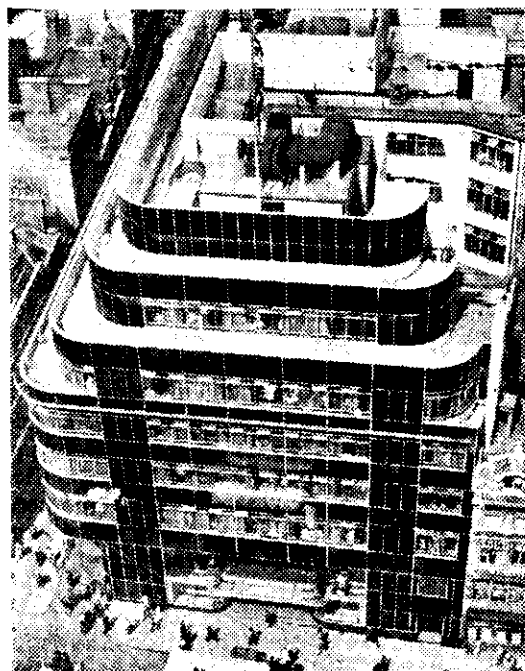


# LOOK BEFORE YOU LISTEN
