"La Cenerentola" (Cinderella), one of Rossini's finest comic operas, was first performed at Rome, in January, 1817, just eleven months after the still more celebrated "Barber of Seville." London heard it—in a badly mutilated version—three years later, but for seventy years it was strangely neglected in England. It had a revival in 1891, and in more recent years it was successfully produced at Covent Garden, with the late Conchita Supervia, the great mezzo-soprano, as Cinderella.

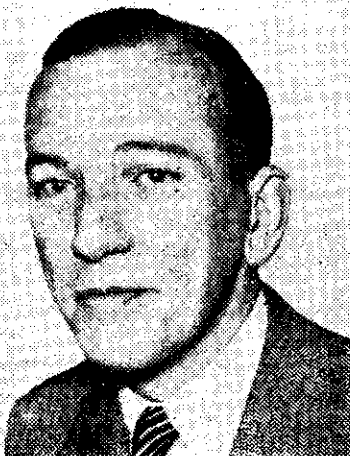
