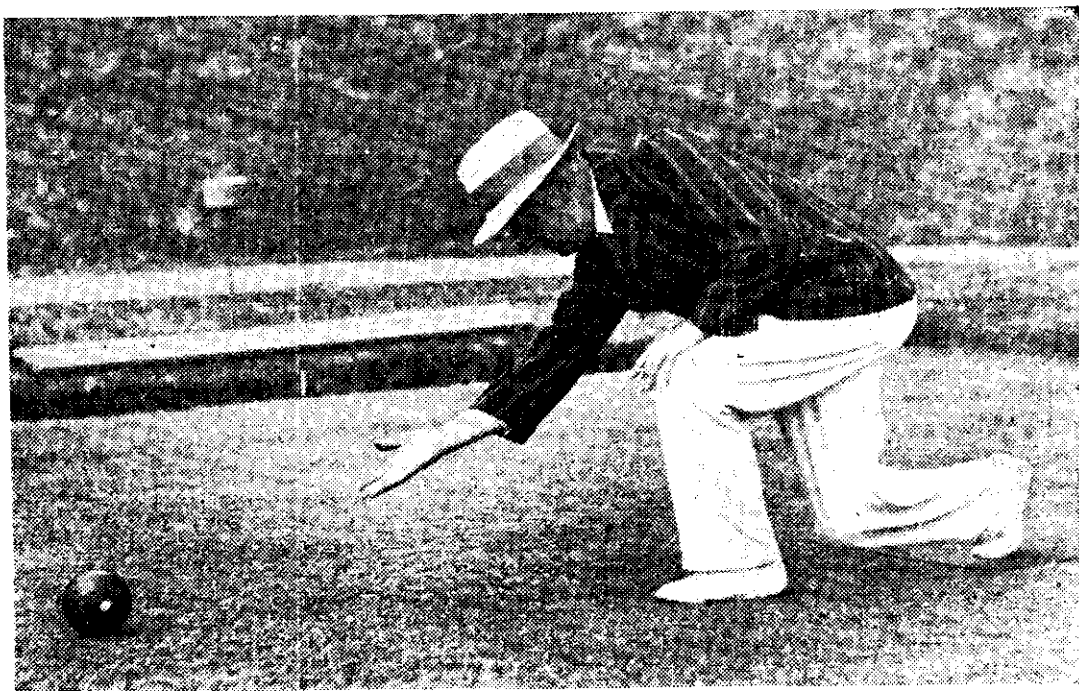


LOOK BEFORE YOU LISTEN
