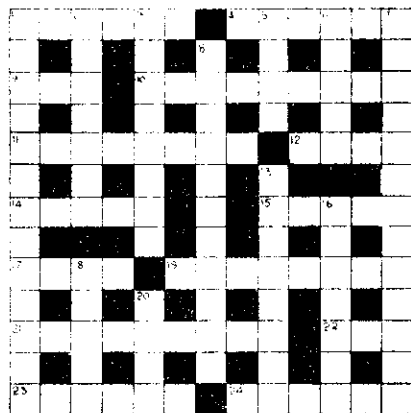


THE LISTENER CROSSWORD

(No. 216: Constructed by R.W.C.)



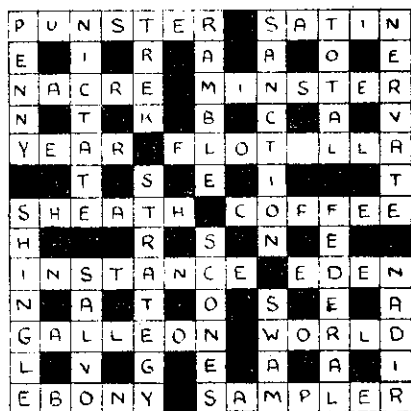

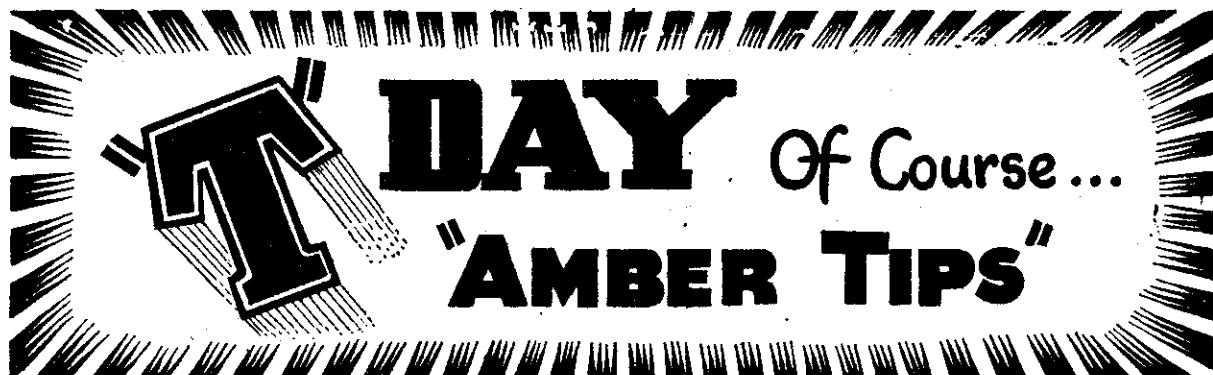
