December 9th

Closely watch germinating seed. Plant celery, cabbage, cauliflower and broccoli. Spray tomatoes and keep clear of weeds. Water lattuce copiously. Sow carrot seed thinly.

December 16th

Sow lettuce seed. Keep climbing beans trained up. Bank up dwarf beans and peas and keep pods picked when tender. When watering give a good soaking.
