WORK FOR WEEK ENDING

December 23rd
Thin parsnips and swedes, and water close to plants. After watering give liquid manure to celery, cabbage and cauliflower. Cut out summer cabbage.

December 30th
Clean up summer cabbage bed, plant leeks in it, and puddle them in. Stop harvesting rhubarb, keep tomatoes pruned, tied and sprayed.
