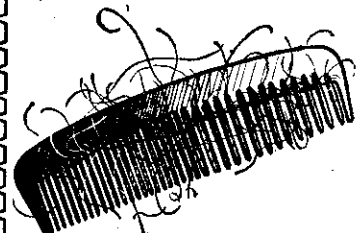
# THE FIRST GOLDFIELD
