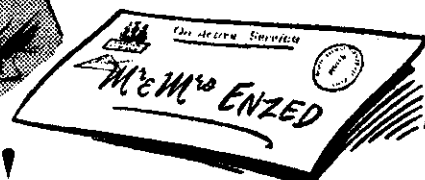

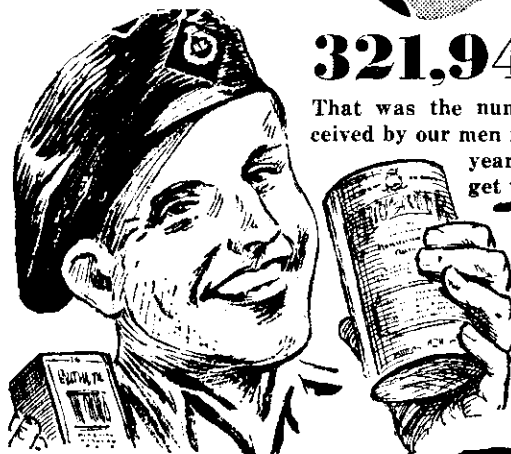


321,942 GRINS!
