UNWASHED HANDS ARE DANGEROUS

Unwashed hands spread disease. Keep yours clean. Plain soap and water, and plenty of it, will do it.

Before handling food or dishes the hands must be carefully washed. Unclean hands and finger-nails which have become soiled through contact with nose, mouth, handkerchief, body waste, discharges or sores, harbour countless germs. Some of them are capable of causing serious illnesses and epidemics.
