Canterbury Music Festival A T the time when Canterbury

AT the time when Canterbury was celebrating its Centennial, and a very successful musical lestival was held in Christchurch as part of the series of testivals arranged throughout the Dominion, it was felt that something should be done after the war about making such occasions a regular leature of the city's musical life. musical life.
