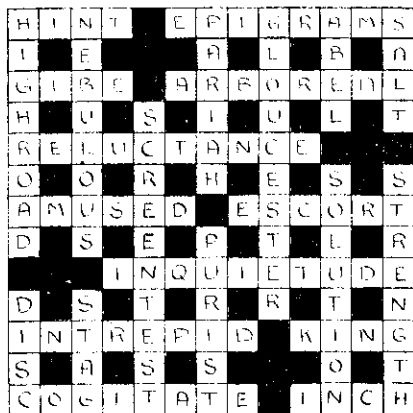


# THE LISTENER CROSSWORD

(Solution to No. 315)



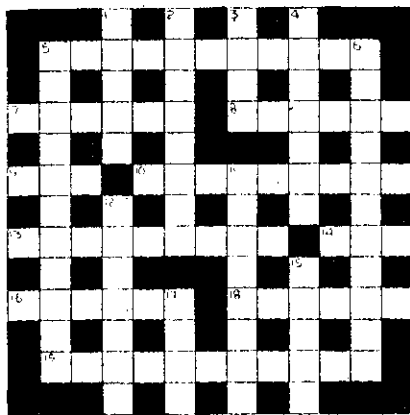
## Clues Across
