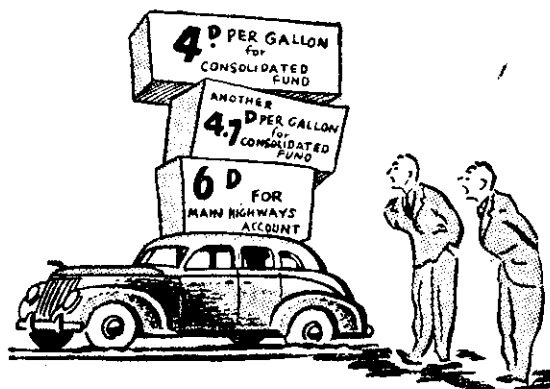


Petrol Taxation to be REDUCED!
