### Farming on a sound basis

Subsidised training under practical farmers for those who haven't quite the experience required. Others may take refresher or topping off courses in agriculture under special grants. Expert advice is given on types of farms, equipment, stock, probable yields and land values. No stone is left unturned to see that the ex-serviceman fitted for farming shall start on a solid basis, and in financial security.
