started their career. During the war they were absent from the concert stage, serving with the Czechoslovak Army based in Britain. Other exponents of the two-piano art are Geraldo and Sidney Bright, Carroll Gibbons and Harry Jacobsen. Ivor Moreton and Dave Kaye and, nearer home, Frank Hutchens and Lindley Evans. All these pianists except Hutchens and Evans, who have arranged Bach preludes and fugues and some Mozart variations for two pianos, play in light vein.

WHEN Britain's new post-war commercial plane, the Vickers Viking, arrived at Whenuapai, a party from 1ZB (Marina, Dudley Wrathall, and technicians) went to meet it. Wrathall covered the arrival, with a description from the control tower and later from the tarmac, and Marina chatted to the two women passengers, Mrs. B. W. A. Dickson, wife of one of the directors of Vickers-Armstrong, and Mrs. M. F. Summers, wife of the test pilot who flew the aircraft. The Viking set her course for New Zealand over the Middle East, India and Australia, the journey taking 10 days.
