THE TEST MATCHES

Cricket Coverage by BBC and NZBS

HE first cricket Test between England and Australia will start on June 10. While ordinary matches of the tour are being covered mainly by the scoreboard on each day of play as well as by Jack Lamason's twice-weekly summaries, special arrangements have been made by the NZBS for the Tests. These arrangements, which are set out below, may have to be modified if any further power cuts are imposed. Listeners with shortwave receivers will be able to tune in as well to the BBC broadcasts, and information about wavelengths will be given from the main National stations following the 9.0 p.m. news each day.




