
A Football Field is not big enough*



in which to stop from $60_{\text{m.p.h.}}$

*An efficiently braked car driven by a competent driver over favourable road conditions and travelling at 60 m.p.h, requires 112 yds. in which to pull up safely — more than the length of a football field.

Speed is Dangerous!

At 40 m.p.h. it takes four times the distance to stop that it does at 20 m.p.h.; at 60 m.p.h. it takes nine times; for stopping distance increases very rapidly as the speed increases, in proportion to the square of the speed. Thus it takes a lot longer to pull up from speed than most drivers realise, so
